Conceptual background of ARAQUA

Council Recommendation (26.11.2018)

Promoting automatic mutual recognition of higher education and upper secondary education and training qualifications and the outcomes of learning periods abroad

Lisbon Recognition Convention, Article 4.1 (1997) "Each Party shall **recognise the qualifications** issued by other Parties meeting the general requirements for **access to higher education** in those Parties for the purpose of access to programmes belonging to its higher education system, unless a substantial difference" exists between the systems

Rome Communiqué (2020)

"Ministers commit to building an **inclusive**, **innovative** and **interconnected EHEA** by 2030, and it will be inclusive, because every learner will have **equitable access to higher education**"

Aim and objectives

Aim


To explore HE access qualifications in the project partner countries in order to map these qualifications and develop recommendations for NARICs and HEIs for their automatic recognition between the countries

HE access qualifications – general upper secondary education qualifications and vocational upper secondary education and training (VET) qualifications ensuring rights to their holders to enrol higher education programmes

Main objectives

- to set criteria of mapping HE access qualifications
- to prepare recommendations for NARICs and HEIs about the automatic recognition of HE access qualifications
- to promote discussion among NARICs and HEIs about the procedures and criteria for automatic recognition of HE access qualifications
