Chronology:

- Agreement among the Government of the Republic of Latvia, the Government of the Republic of Estonia and the Government of the Republic of Lithuania, on the creation of a common educational space in general upper secondary education and vocational (up to higher education level) education within the Baltic States
 - Signed on 10.07.1998, entered into force on 16.07.2000
- **AURBELL** (2014-2016) NARIC project «Automatic Recognition between Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania»
 - The aim of the project was to elaborate proposals for the revision of the previous agreement and develop guidelines for the automatic recognition in the Baltic States for HE qualifications and HE access qualifications
- Agreement among the Government of the Republic of Estonia, the Government of the Republic of Latvia and the Government of the Republic of Lithuania on the automatic academic recognition of qualifications concerning higher education
 - Signed on 08.06.2018, entered into force on 07.01.2019



Challenges faced by AIC after the agreement entered in force

- Higher education institutions were confused which credentials issued in Estonia and Lithuania have to be sent to AIC for evaluation
- Private individuals were not widely informed about the existence of the agreement
- The credential evaluators themselves also had to consider whether the issued document should be accepted for recognition
- In cases when the credential was issued after 07.01.2019, the applicant is informed about the automatic recognition between Baltic States
