





Kozminski University as an example


- 1. Main assumption was the ease of finding the most interesting information to potential student
- 2. Going down the levels of website, more and more detailed information can be found
- 3. The information that is valid for the ,smallest' groups of people can be found on the bottom levels knowledge base and "BIP"
- 4. Information targeted at a candidate is separated from information targeted at current students, graduates and staff.








KU solution

The solution will offer:

- 1. General information about Kozminski University, degree awarding rights, accreditations, rankings, diplomas,
- 2. Information on how to access the "BIP" website of KU, how to use it and how to look for BIP of other universities,
- 3. General information on Polish system of education,
- 4. Information on how to access POL-ON and RAD-ON databases, holding important information, like:
 - Accredited universities and programs
 - Doctoral schools
 - Database of Ph.D. graduates and students
- 5. I'm also working to add detailed overview of Polish higher education regulations.







Conclusions and recommendations

- 1. Very often required information, although available, is dispersed in different places or hidden behind passwords
- 2. It is worth creating solutions that will assist evaluators by gathering all of the information in one place
- 3. Transparency is crucial, course catalogues should eventually become a standard for universities
- 4. The task at hand might be difficult for universities to handle alone, thus it would be highly recommended to integrate course catalogues with national systems or databases, like "BIP"
