- Qualifications accepted for HE access tend to be included in national registers of the regulator

UCAS tariff

- Recognised qualifications carry a UCAS tariff point value
- Only RQF / CQFW level 3 or SCQF level 6 qualifications carry tariff points
- This may include NVQ / SVQ qualifications too
